



2016-2017 Fees and Tuition

All fees as well as June and July tuition payments are non-refundable and non-transferable.

UPPER SCHOOL STUDENTS attend a mandatory RETREAT in September with a cost of approximately \$195. The cost will be charged to student accounts and may be paid in three monthly installments from September to November.

TASTE OF FLORENCE TICKETS On Registration Day, each family will receive 10 tickets to sell for \$5 each for the Taste of Florence. Family accounts will be charged \$50 in October, but the money may be recovered as tickets are sold.

CLASS OVERNIGHT TRIPS Students in 5th - 12th grades may be afforded educational travel opportunities yearly which incur additional charges. Information will be made available as it is determined.

TUITION DISCOUNTS for families with 3 or more full-time students enrolled at TKA receive a multiple child discount. After the first two full tuitions, the third child receives a 50 % discount, the fourth child receives a 75% discount and any additional children attend free. Discounts apply to students' tuition in the order of youngest to oldest. Children of pastors who meet the qualifications receive a 10% discount.

HOME SCHOOL STUDENTS Students who are currently home schooled with a registered Home School Association and take classes at TKA are required to pay a one-time \$75.00 Application Fee plus prorated Registration and Enrollment Deposit fees, based on the number of classes for which a student is enrolled. Tuition is as follows: Middle School classes are \$1,037 per class and Upper School classes are \$1,083 per class. The SCISA requirement of four core classes must be met in order to participate in SCISA events. The maximum number of classes allowed is five.

FINANCIAL AID: TKA desires to offer financial aid to families who demonstrate need. In order to be considered for assistance, you must submit an application each academic year. Information is available through our Admissions Office and/or an online financial aid website –FAST. Applications for financial aid will be considered only if the student has made application to TKA and paid the Application and Registration Fee. The application process must be completed by March 31, 2016. The Financial Aid Committee will meet in April 2015 to distribute funds. Parents are responsible for all fees. Financial aid is applied to tuition only. Initial distribution of funds will be according to the March deadline. Any additional applicants will be considered as funds become available from April until July.
