Dear Parents of Rising 2nd & 3rd Grade Students,

As a school we have seen the benefits to our summer reading program. Statistics tell us how very important it is for students to keep up their reading skills over the summer. It is our goal at TKA that our students come back refreshed from summer break, but also on track and ready to jump back into learning. Students are asked to read at least 10 books over the summer. We do ask that students choose books that they have not read before. After reading each book, the student should write down the title and author. These books should be listed on the attached rating log, placed in a folder, and turned in on the first day of school. A parent signature will also be required. We will count 10 books as a 100 in reading for the first nine weeks of the next school year. Any student who exceeds 10 book will also receive any all-day homework pass. Please encourage you child to read as much as possible over this summer. We would love to see 100% participation. Happy Reading!
