

Middle School Scriptures 2018-2019

Aug 20th- 1 Peter 2:9- But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God's special possession, that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light.

Aug. 27th- 1 Peter 2:10- Once you were not a people, but now you are the people of God; once you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy.

Sept. 3rd- Revelation 1:8- I am the Alpha and the Omega, says the Lord God, who is, and who was, and who is to come, the Almighty.

Sept. 10th- 1 Peter 5:7-8- Cast all your anxiety on him because he cares for you. Be alert and of sober mind. Your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour.

Sept. 17th- 1 Peter 2:24- He himself bore our sins in his body on the cross, so that we might die to sins and live for righteousness; by his wounds you have been healed.

Sept. 24th- Proverbs 30:5- Every word of God is flawless; he is a shield to those who take refuge in him.

Oct. 1- Revelation 4:11- You are worthy, our Lord and God, to receive glory and honor and power, for you created all things, and by your will they were created and have their being.

Oct. 8- Ephesians 2:4-5- But because of his great love for us, God, who is rich in mercy, ⁵ made us alive with Christ even when we were dead in transgressions—it is by grace you have been saved.

Oct. 15- Colossians 1:16-17- For in him all things were created: things in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or powers or rulers or authorities; all things have been created through him and for him.¹⁷ He is before all things, and in him all things hold together.

Oct. 22- Psalm 18:30-31- ³⁰ As for God, his way is perfect: The LORD's word is flawless; he shields all who take refuge in him. ³¹ For who is God besides the LORD? And who is the Rock except our God?

Oct. 29- Hebrews 5:8-9- ⁸ Son though he was, he learned obedience from what he suffered⁹ and, once made perfect, he became the source of eternal salvation for all who obey him.

Nov. 5- Isaiah 41:10- So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with my righteous right hand.

Nov. 12- Hebrews 13:17- Have confidence in your leaders and submit to their authority, because they keep watch over you as those who must give an account. Do this so that their work will be a joy, not a burden, for that would be of no benefit to you.

Nov. 26- Titus 2:11-12- ¹¹ For the grace of God has appeared that offers salvation to all people.¹² It teaches us to say "No" to ungodliness and worldly passions, and to live self-controlled, upright and godly lives in this present age.

Dec. 3- John 14:12- My Father's house has many rooms; if that were not so, would I have told you that I am going there to prepare a place for you?

Dec. 10- Isaiah 9:6- For to us a child is born, to us a son is given, and the government will be on his shoulders. And he will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.

Jan 7- 2 Corinthians 5:21- God made him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.

Jan. 14- John 10:10- The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full.

Jan. 21- Joel 2:28- And afterward, I will pour out my Spirit on all people. Your sons and daughters will prophesy, your old men will dream dreams, your young men will see visions.

Jan. 28- Luke 6:38- Give, and it will be given to you. A good measure, pressed down, shaken together and running over, will be poured into your lap. For with the measure you use, it will be measured to you.

Feb. 4- Colossians 3:2-3- Set your minds on things above, not on earthly things. ³ For you died, and your life is now hidden with Christ in God.

Feb. 11- James 4:17- If anyone, then, knows the good they ought to do and doesn't do it, it is sin for them.

Feb. 18- 2 Corinthians 9:6- Remember this: Whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows generously will also reap generously.

Feb. 25- Acts 1:8- But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.

March 4- Matthew 28:19-20- ¹⁹ Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, ²⁰ and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.”

March 18- Matthew 26:41- “Watch and pray so that you will not fall into temptation. The spirit is willing, but the flesh is weak.”

March 25- John 1:14- The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the one and only Son, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth.

April 1- 2 Peter 3:10- But the day of the Lord will come like a thief. The heavens will disappear with a roar; the elements will be destroyed by fire, and the earth and everything done in it will be laid bare.

April 8- Genesis 2:24- That is why a man leaves his father and mother and is united to his wife, and they become one flesh.

April 15- Job 19:25- I know that my redeemer lives, and that in the end he will stand on the earth.

April 29- Revelation 19:9- Then the angel said to me, “Write this: Blessed are those who are invited to the wedding supper of the Lamb!” And he added, “These are the true words of God.”

May 6- 1 Corinthians 6:18- Flee from sexual immorality. All other sins a person commits are outside the body, but whoever sins sexually, sins against their own body.

May 13- 1 Corinthians 6:19- Do you not know that your bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from God? You are not your own.

May 20- Ephesians 4:31-32- ³¹ Get rid of all bitterness, rage and anger, brawling and slander, along with every form of malice. ³² Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you.
